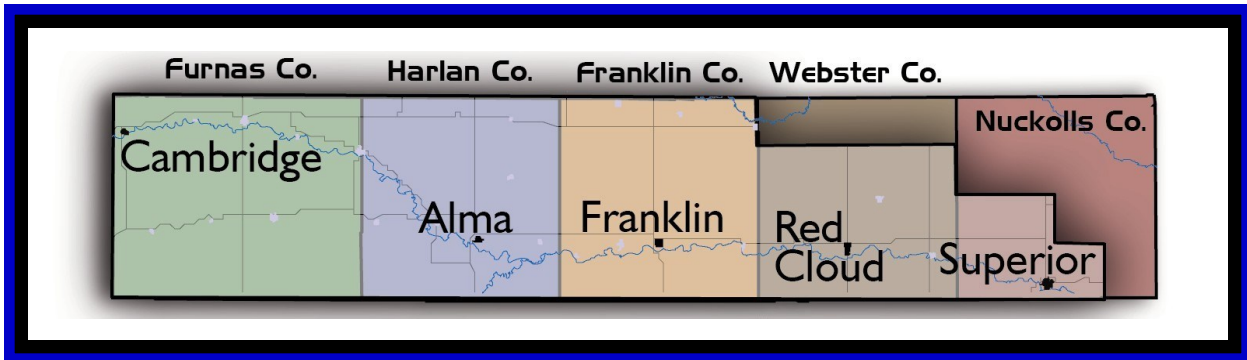


LOWER REPUBLICAN NATURAL RESOURCES DISTRICT POST HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must have permanent residence in the Lower Republican NRD (see district map) and plan to major in a natural resources related field (i.e. forestry, park management, agronomy, agri-business, etc.)
- Scholarships are available to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd year college students, applicants must attend college in Nebraska and must be registered full-time at their college. Scholarship cannot be awarded to the same recipient more than twice.
- Applicant's essay, grades, class ranking if applicable, extracurricular activities, and letters of recommendation will be considered,
- The LRNRD Scholarship Committee will make the final award decision,
- Applications must be in the LRNRD office in Alma by **April 1, 2018**.
