Chris Miller, Miller & Associates is continuing to evaluate the feasibility of stream augmentation for the Republican River. Initially the study had 9 sites; adding sites along the way. As they examined the sites they asked what would be the requirements of a site since there is no classification for an augmentation well. They have been treating them as an industrial well. The question was asked how will it be handled and what are the local impacts. Stream depletions will be handled by the Republican River Compact. Local impacts and requirements are different in each district. Miller & Associates have developed some method to evaluate these sites of local impacts.

John P. McCarley PhD, Innovative Water Technologies gave a presentation to the board on the Hydrological Cycle and Effects of Electrical Excitation of Water to the board. A copy of this presentation is in the minute book.

Mike Clements talked to the board about rearranging the office.

Brad said he offered this as his testimony at the MRNRD and URNRD meetings.
