Olsson Associates, Karen O'Connor and Paul Woodward presented the LRNRD Board with an Agreement for Professional Services. They are working on an Augmentation Feasibility Study "Project" to hopefully discover ways to

limit irrigation usage in future years. A copy of the agreement is in the minute book. Mike Delka spoke to the board about a potential storage site area along Beaver Creek.

Motion #3 by Toby tenBensel seconded by Dave Bartels to accept Olsson Associates letter Agreement for Professional Services. Motion Carried. Mike Clements presented to the board the adoption of Amendment No. two to the NARD 414(h) Retirement Plan and the 457 Deferred Compensation Plan. This will bring the plans up-to-date and into compliance.

Mike Clements handed out water usage papers on Leroy Harm's meter violations. Field Technician's read the meter in July finding the usage to be 4.83" and again in August the usage was at 10.03". Mike Clements spoke earlier with Marlin Murdoch about the usage amounts and Marlin felt the figures were pretty accurate. The board discussed a penalty; instead decided to require the meter be replaced with a new mechanical flow meter before next year's growing season.

Motion #6 by Brad Wulf seconded by Bill Bose to require Leroy Harms to install a new mechanical flow meter on well G-010017 in SE 3-15-24 on or before the April 1, 2013 growing season. Comments from the public: Senator Mark Christensen approached the board about water short years and suggested a different approach to avoid a Compact Call Year. The senator stated that we are under correlative rights where we share and share alike, and feels that if quick response (or rapid response) wells are shut off we are headed for a lawsuit. Senator Christensen suggested to the directors that giving the irrigator's five inch per acre allocation but allow the producer to do their management and use it on the site they want to. Christensen feels this would treat producers equally and fairly. As we enter a potential water short year, Christensen thinks it is going to be a quick lawsuit and the judge could shut everyone down. Director's thanked him for his thoughts, and stated they already thought about those matters.

Mike Clements presented the FY2013 budget to the board.
