Jerry Kovarik gave the NRCS report. A copy of this report is in the minute book.

Mike Clements brought to the board's attention a well was reported running with an inoperable electronic flow meter. The meter was in place but the power cables that were attached to a battery were unhooked. A certified letter was mailed to owner Leroy Harms. Board discussion was held with Leroy and it was decided to find out the current water usage and to table this discussion until next month.

Mike Clements introduced Karen O'Connor from Olsson & Associates. The board discussed a potential augmentation project with Karen. She will be getting an estimate prepared for the board to review at the August meeting.

Bryan Lubeck updated the board on the four ET gauges that were purchased by the NRD. The Extension office has several people willing to continue to keep track of information received through the gauges. This information will be collected and recorded on a website. Details to come.

Motion #3 by Bill Bose seconded by Marlin Murdoch move that the Board go into Executive session at 7:30 p.m. to discuss updates on the KS vs. NE lawsuit. Motion carried. Mike presented the board with the FY 2013 Occupation tax budget. He had it split into two different budgets, a \$5 per acre tax and the other a \$10 per acre tax.

Mike Clements discussed with the board retaining the services of Consultant Pat Underwood on an as-needed basis. The agreement runs from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013. The service provided will be grant writing and resource development services.

Motion #6 by Brad Wulf seconded by Dave Bartels to retain the services of Consultant Pat Underwood and that the Consultant hereby agrees to provide grant writing and resources development consultation services on an as-needed basis under the terms and conditions of the agreement. Mike Clements discussed an Environmental Grant application for soil moisture sensors. This would be for a total of 616 sets of sensors for \$338,800, LRNRD cash match will be \$30,800.
